LATEST STAFFING NEWS

HOT OFF THE PRESS—Congratulations to James Hill, our Band conductor and Arts Alive conductor for his appointment to a K-12 independent school as Head of Performing Arts. This is a significant promotion and achievement for James and we know that it is well deserved. James has a long standing history with Belrose PS which spans for over 19 years. As well as being an outstanding trumpeter, he is an outstanding teacher and exceptional conductor who has assisted our students through the musical progressions from training band to performance band. We wish to say farewell to him at our Stage 3 Presentation assembly next Tuesday night. The P&C and Band committee have already secured conductors for Term 1 with further discussions about long term placements to take place early next year. A big thank you to Andrew Fairclough for his assistance.

Mrs Thoroughgood, who is a permanent teacher at Belrose, will be taking leave for 2019 due to family commitments. Mrs Wilkinson, who has been employed as a temporary teacher for a number of years will not be on class. We thank both of these teachers for their extraordinary patience, care, enthusiasm and expert teaching with K-2 students. Both Mrs Thoroughgood and Mrs Wilkinson will be at Belrose from time to time for day-to-day casual teaching during 2019. We also thank Mrs Mavromatis for teaching Music, KD on a Friday and for her support with our composite classes. We thank her for her flexibility as she had a number of teaching roles within the school. Mrs Mavromatis is seeking full-time employment closer to her home. With these changes to staffing, we plan to have 10 classes with full-time teachers in 2019. Classroom teachers will be Mrs Meikle, Mr Warren, Miss Jarvis, Mrs Green, Mr Davidson, Mrs Staples, Mrs Iwakurra and Mrs Denver, Mrs Stephens, Mrs Meteyard, Mrs Kabalan and Mrs Killick.

Mrs de Wilde and I conducted interviews with a number teachers who expressed an interest with teaching at Belrose PS. We are pleased to announce that Mrs Michelle Kabalan has been appointed as a temporary classroom teacher for 2019. Mrs Kabalan is a very experienced teacher and Relieving Assistant Principal, previously from Allambie Heights PS and Brooklyn PS who has a background in Accelerated Literacy, Reading Recovery and is a specialist teacher in K-2. We welcome her to Belrose PS for 2019 and thank her for attending the K-2 Awards Day along with Mrs Louise Green, our new Assistant Principal.


