We are very fortunate in having a dedicated team of teachers and support staff. TEXTBOOKS

Teachers wish to supplement their teaching learning programs sometimes with a few textbooks. 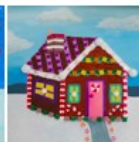

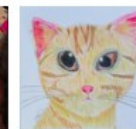
