

Principal's Message

STUDENT WELLBEING, OUR PRIORITY

Due to Belrose Public School's passion, engagement and diversity of wellbeing perspectives, our school has been identified as a leading school to inform the Future State of Wellbeing Services across NSW Schools. This current study, through Pricewaterhouse Coopers Consulting, is allowing us to share our practices to guide the Departmental initiatives. We are honoured to be part of this initiative. Many of our younger students



have been asking me about next year's badge colour, of which is TOP SECRET (Why ruin a surprise!). Claudia has kindly offered to share a photograph of her achievement of Gold Award badges over the last five years. She is one of many students who are kind and considerate, respectful, responsible and always trying to achieve her best.

WHAT WILL 2022 LOOK LIKE AT BELROSE

On the very first day of school, Tuesday, 1 February, 2022, Year 1 and Year 2 students from 9:00am will be placed in their classes, with Years 3 to 6 knowing their teachers when we return from the Swimming Carnival in the afternoon. Our new Kindergarten students will begin their first day of school on Thursday, 3 February when they will meet their new Year 6 buddies for the year. We are excited to have all of our year 1 students together in a class, as well as all of our year 2 students together for 2022.

We provide additional support with three teachers' aides working within classrooms to ensure the wellbeing and personalised learning of all students within the school. Well known to the students, Mrs Judson, Mrs Watson and Mrs Maye will continue to provide additional support, both within the classroom and on the playground before school, at recess and at lunch time. Our Learning and Support Teacher will continue to provide extensive evidenced-based literacy and numeracy support through many avenues, including our MiniLit, MacqLit and Reading Tutor Programs. Mrs Staples has been pleased to accept an exciting role dear to her heart, of teaching Kindergarten to Year 2 Geography and History lessons, as well as teaching the extensive learning support program, as part of funding received by the Federal Government as a result of COVID. Each classroom teacher will have an additional half and hour each week for one-on-one assessments in literacy and numeracy.

STRATEGIC STAFFING STRUCTURES:

Along with our positive Wellbeing practices, we have also been able to secure additional personnel with Numeracy expertise to continue our successful academic growth from Kindergarten to Year 6. Thank you to the Executive Team for assisting me with this proposal for additional finances for Belrose Public school. As we move to implement the new K-2 Literacy and Numeracy syllabus in 2023, a number of staff will continue to be instructional leaders with co-planning, co-teaching and co-de-briefing within classes from Kindergarten to Year 6.

EXTRA CURRICULAR LESSONS

We have ensured ample teaching and playground time for students to mix with others in their year levels as well as develop further relationships with students younger and older than themselves. In 2022, each Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 student will now be taught Music, Japanese, Library, Geography, History and Gymnastics within their own class group.

In 2022, the Geography and History syllabus for years 3-6 will return to be integrated into lessons by the class teachers with Miss Wedlock taking the lead role in teaching PD/Health/PE lessons as well as the literacy focus in library. These lessons will be for 90 minutes each week. Student will be required to wear their sports uniforms on these days.

Other specialised lessons include:

Kindergarten to Year 4—30 minute music lessons with Conservatorium of Music Graduate. Miss Whittard

Kindergarten to Year 4—30 minute Japanese language lessons with Mrs Iwakura

Years 5 and 6—60 minute Creative Arts lessons of Dance and Music with Miss Whittard

Kindergarten to Year 2—PD/Health/PE lessons together each Friday with their teachers

Kindergarten to Year 6—Technology will continue to be integrated into all class teaching and learning programs. We do not require parents to purchase Bring Your Own Devices as the school has access to 30 desk tops in the computer lab, multiple lap tops and ipads within each classroom along with 90 inch touchscreen interactive display boards. We will have an additional STEM and film making lab next to the computer room which will be booked by teachers, as required.

Planning days will be part of the Staff Development Day in Week 1. This time is essential for teachers to continue our positive culture of inclusivity and collaboration. We have high expectations at Belrose PS and are always improving the capacity of our teaching practices. Thank you to the highly professional and very supportive and caring hardworking teachers and admin staff.

One of the most favourable parts of being at a school of our size is the diverse opportunities that your children have. This in turn assists with creating children who are confident, social, resilient and risk takers. All schools, no matter the size, are only permitted to have the same number of sporting groups within inter-school competitions. This is great news as your child may attend band, choir, dance groups, sporting teams, chess teams, zone carnivals in swimming, cross county and athletics.

SPORT

Belrose Public School will continue to gain sporting schools grants of \$2,500.00-\$3,000 each term so that professional sports people attend the school to teach a variety of sports eg basketball and cricket. Using the skills of our former state player in softball, Miss Panetta will continue to lead the softball team. Other sports will be T-ball, netball, soccer, cricket and tennis.

PERFORMING ARTS

All students' creativity will be enhanced through:

- -Specialised Music lessons Kindergarten to Year 6
- -Training and Performance Band with our highly skilled and experienced conductors, Mrs Anderson and Mrs Fyfe with band tours each November, eisteddfods and music festivals
- -Kindergarten to Year 2 choir and Year 3 to 6 choir
- -Three Dance groups
- -K-2 Musicale in Term 3

CHESS AND ICAS COMPETITION

Chess Coaching Classes and within-school competition will continue as well as all NSW's ICAS Competitions .

SUSTAINABILITY AND ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION

Working in partnership with Kimbriki Resource Recovery Centre assists our staff and Eco Warrior student group with educating all students about our Veggie Garden and recycling processes of soft plastics, paper and co-mingling.

We look forward to welcoming 2022 along with our new adventure playground.
