Could you please help Santa's Sleigh and the Lions Club of Frenchs Forest to run the Sleigh in our local area?

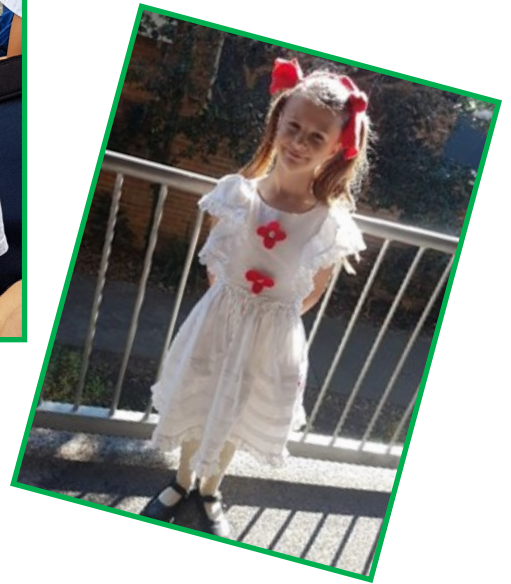


